Dear Mr. Oder:

The City of Hampton Wetlands Board ("the Board") has completed a review of the subject application seeking authorization to rehabilitate and add to an existing 105-foot pier by making it 6 feet wider and adding a 40-foot by 12-foot "T-head" on the Chesapeake Bay in the City of Hampton. The outcome of the review is as follows:

1. The project proposes permitted uses or activities within the Board's jurisdiction or does not involve lands that are within the Board's jurisdiction; therefore, pursuant to Chapter 41.1 of the Code of the City of Hampton, **no permit is necessary from the Board.**
2. If the project, as reported in the subject application, changes during the permitting process or during construction, the project may be returned to the Board's purview.
3. Additional authorizations or permits may be required by the City of Hampton (e.g. building permit, land disturbing permit), U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Virginia Marine Resources Commission, and Virginia Department of Environmental Quality.

While the activity you wish to perform is permissible under the City of Hampton Wetlands Ordinance, you still are subject to the regulations of that Ordinance. We ask that you observe the following with regard to your project:

1. Notify the Environmental Inspector (311 or 757-727-8311) one day prior to commencement of construction activity.
2. Permit access to the Environmental Inspector during construction in order to ensure proper and appropriate construction practices.
3. Notify the Environmental Inspector upon completion of construction.
